TPM, South Korean Firm To Collaborate On RE Power Generation

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 30 (Bernama) -- Technology Park Malaysia Corporation Sdn Bhd (TPM) and Green Planet Energy Co Ltd (GPE) of South Korea today inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to jointly collaborate in the renewable energy (RE) large-scale solar farm and biomass projects.

Upon the signing of a definitive agreement between both parties, TPM was expected to become the exclusive distributor representative/resources of GPE's solar-powered products, with technical support, in Malaysia for the next 10 years, TPM said in a statement today.

GPE was established in 2014 and its core business is in RE power generation.

The MoU was signed by TPM President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Datuk Ir Mohd Azman Shahidin and GPE CEO, Dong Jin Sin.

Mohd Azman said the collaboration could possibly see the establishment of a special purpose vehicle as the power purchasing entity of RE (PPE), whose consumption shall be less than 100 megawatts per year.....
